

# How to use the BITEBUSTER PROTECTIVE SYSTEM!

Due to the fact that our safety line is developed by pet professionals along with research chemists from major glove manufacturers, we are well aware that pet professionals need options when it comes to safety wear. The battle between hand and arm dexterity and protection levels is a constant. We feel that our line is the best of what is available to give both. It is up to your establishment to create your own directions on use but here are some helpful tips from the field.



The padded sleeves are great for shaving cats or pilling an animal when you need your fingers to be able to move and feel. Unlike many sleeves, ours has protection for the back of the hand which is a very vulnerable area when performing these tasks!



Add our scratchbusters underneath for more protection without sacrificing too much dexterity. The nitrile coated palms and fingertips over the cut and scratch resistant Dyneema® also helps in gripping animals or tools.

If a fear biting animal lunges at your hand or arm, sometimes it is good to try to pull your fingers back into the glove and the animal might only get your glove, therefore reducing the crushing risk. You may then have a better chance of reaching around with your other gloved arm to restrain him.



The padded sleeves and nitrile liners are a great combination to use while bathing pets that may be nervous. This line of safetywear was designed to be used in water where many pets become anxious.

The EXTREME Gauntlets are the most protective gloves of our line. They have the most puncture and crush resistance while amazingly, are still very dexterous! They can even fit over the padded sleeve with the scratchbusters or nitrile liners for even more protection options! The thick nitrile lining also keeps associate's arms dry when used for bathing.
